CONVERIS RESEARCH MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE TO REPLACE IRMA IN SEPT 2018

The University is in the process of replacing the IRMA system with a Research Management system called Converis (see <https://clarivate.com/products/converis/>)

This system is currently being developed for implementation at UKZN in September 2018. The Publications and Ethics modules will go live in September 2018.

The Research Office requests that researchers refrain from uploading their 2018 outputs into the current IRMA System, as all 2018 submissions will be processed via the Converis System only. The IRMA System will not be functional from end June 2018.

For those who have already uploaded their research outputs for 2018 into IRMA, you will be required uploaded into Converis as well, once we go live. Our apologies in advance for any inconvenience caused. The Converis system has the capability of extracting publications information from multiple databases such as PubMed, Scopus and Web of Science, using ORCID codes. NB. There will also be a series of Training sessions for the Converis System that will take place in July and August 2018. The training schedule will be communicated in due course. Additionally, you will be required to check your profile information (extracted from ITS) prior to September 2018. You will be notified as to when you can access the Converis system

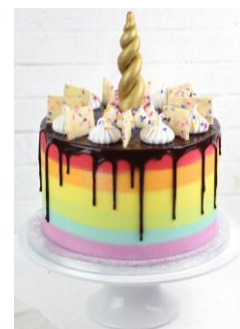
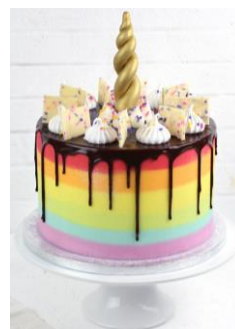
