

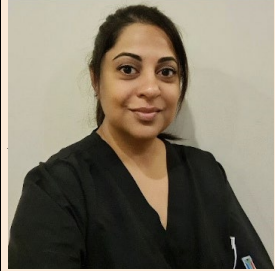

Clinical skills tutor at the Nelson R Mandela School of Medicine, Dr Leanthea Enoch is the prestigious winner of the 2022 Southern African Association of Health Educationalists Award.

SAHHE is an association of health sciences educators from South African Universities, NGOs and government and private sectors. It aims on improving the quality of teaching and learning in health sciences education so as to enhance the delivery of high-quality, affordable and sustainable healthcare to South Africans in both the public and private sectors.

Enoch won the oral presentation category for her Masters of Medical Science research presentation titled: *Assessing Medical Students' Ability to Bridge the Theory Practice Gap in Clinical Skills Following Online Learning during the COVID-19 Pandemic.*

The study explored innovative changes provided to an online clinical skills curriculum during the Covid-19 pandemic.'

Enoch's study highlights the value and importance of a blended learning strategy in the undergraduate medical education programme with the need to incorporate a digital curriculum that uses varied instructional designs and assessments to support traditional teaching methods. Her experience in the health sciences field started with a Bachelor's degree in Physiotherapy at the former University of Durban-Westville (now UKZN). She holds a Postgraduate Diploma in Anaesthesia and is currently completing her Master's in Medical Science through UKZN whilst working as an Anaesthetist at Prince Mshiyeni Memorial Hospital.

UKZN NOTICE 2022 SCM TRAVEL FUNDING

Applications are welcome for all types of conferences. Deadline: 12th August 2022.

Applicants to complete all sections and supply all the supporting documentation by no later than 12th August. An applicant may not receive funding two years in a row to ensure a degree of fair and equitable distribution. Approval is subject to the availability of funds. To qualify, the applicant must be presenting a paper. Evidence must be provided of acceptance upon submission of the application.

- A max. of R10,000pp is awarded on domestic travel, and a max. of R20,000pp for international travel. The use of the funds must be in accordance with UKZN Financial policies and procedures and be directed through the School Finance Office. Before incurring any expenditure, please engage with the School Finance Office via scmtravel@ukzn.ac.za
- Pre-approval is essential, i.e., that you have gone ahead and incurred expenses before approval is granted will not be a factor in our decision, and you will have to accept the risk that you may not be reimbursed
- There will be no transfer of funds to another cost center. For audit purposes, expenditure has to take place against the School cost center. The only exception to this is the payment of the registration fee.
- Funds have to be spent before 30 November of the year in which the award is made. There will be NO carryover of funding from one year to the next.
- Should an applicant be awarded, for example, R10,000 and only use R8,000, the balance of R2,000 will be reallocated by the School to assist another applicant
- Successful applicants will be required to submit an abstract to the College of Health Sciences Research Symposium and participate if selected. Further information will be provided.
- Feedback of the congress proceedings must be presented to the relevant department within three months of your return and evidence of such feedback to be submitted to: scm_conf_fund@ukzn.ac.za

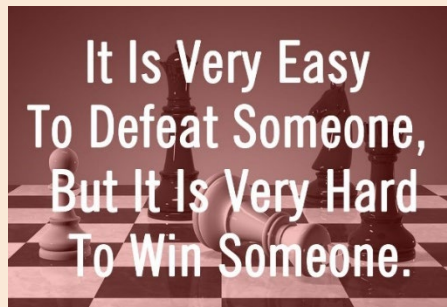

ON THIS DAY....29 JULY

- 2006 USA California Heat Wave. The Heat Wave in California which started on July 16th and reached temperatures of 115 degrees, claimed the lives of over 140 people, caused a massive toll to the state's agricultural industry with damage to peaches, plums, nectarines and walnuts and thousands of livestock lost.
- 2007 Iraq Wins Asian Cup. Despite being a country torn apart by invasion and internal fighting, the Iraqi football team was able to win the Asian Cup against Saudi Arabia on this day. The game, played in Indonesia, ended with a 1-0 score. The victory was able to bring temporary joy to the country which had been plagued with a surge of violence at the time.
