PROCEDURES DOCUMENT FOR BIOSTATISTICIANS

The Biostatistics Unit is in the Discipline of Public Health Medicine in the School of Nursing and Public Health. The aim of the Unit is to support the research function of the University by providing Teaching and Learning, Research, and Biostatistical Support Services. The Unit supports academics and students with their research, and the nature and extent of the research should be such that it would result being published in an accredited journal.

The unit mainly offers biostatistical support services to academics and students in the College of Health Sciences. Currently, there are four statisticians who provide biostatistical support services through online and physical consultations.

Booking a Consultation

An appointment to see a biostatistics consultant can be made using an online booking system (via this link: <http://my.setmore.com/bookingpage/f3dbcb01-8d3d-4a3f-880a-0029c5273367>). Note appointments can only be made via the online booking system and not directly with the consultants. 1-hour slots are available Monday-Friday 9am- 5pm, with a maximum of one slot per individual per week. Please include a short description of the purpose/requirements of each biostatistical support consultation in the booking form

(under “Comments”). Academics and students should make appointments with their UKZN emails, instead of their personal emails.

Consultations are conducted online since the COVID era;

NB: It is mandatory that academics and students wishing to make an appointment for a biostatistics consultation must first have completed the first of the online biostatistics modules via UKZN learn (Introductory Biostatistics, Part 1: <https://learn2022.ukzn.ac.za/user/view.php?id=1704&course=19040>)

They must produce a proof or certificate of course completion before making a statistical consultation. This course is free and self-enrollable on Moodle.

UKZN NOTICE 2022 SCM TRAVEL FUNDING

Applications are welcome for all types of conferences. **Deadline: 12th August 2022.**

Applicants to complete all sections and supply all the supporting documentation by no later than 12th August. An applicant may not receive funding two years in a row to ensure a degree of fair and equitable distribution. Approval is subject to the availability of funds. To qualify, the applicant must be presenting a paper. Evidence must be provided of acceptance upon submission of the application.

- A max. of R10,000pp is awarded on domestic travel, and a max. of R20,000pp for international travel. The use of the funds must be in accordance with UKZN Financial policies and procedures and be directed through the School Finance Office. Before incurring any expenditure, please engage with the School Finance Office via scmtravel@ukzn.ac.za
- Pre-approval is essential, i.e., that you have gone ahead and incurred expenses before approval is granted will not be a factor in our decision, and you will have to accept the risk that you may not be reimbursed
- There will be no transfer of funds to another cost center. For audit purposes, expenditure has to take place against the School cost center. The only exception to this is the payment of the registration fee.
- Funds have to be spent before 30 November of the year in which the award is made. There will be NO carryover of funding from one year to the next.
- Should an applicant be awarded, for example, R10,000 and only use R8,000, the balance of R2,000 will be reallocated by the School to assist another applicant
- Successful applicants will be required to submit an abstract to the College of Health Sciences Research Symposium and participate if selected. Further information will be provided.
- Feedback of the congress proceedings must be presented to the relevant department within three months of your return and evidence of such feedback to be submitted to: scm_conf_fund@ukzn.ac.za
