OPEN ACCESS PAYMENT

There have been many requests to the CHS Research Office to subsidise Open Access publications. Central Research Office does subsidise Open Access publications, depending on the Q rating of the journal.

A limited budget was set to help offset some of these costs. CHS Research Office will pay a maximum of R 15 000 for an Open Access manuscript (does not depend on the Q rating of the journal). The conditions of this award are:

1. Requestor/s to provide evidence and motivation to show that no funds are available to pay for the manuscript
2. A limit of at least three Open Access manuscripts per author/group of authors
3. To claim, the published pdf, invoice and cc that will be sent to Central Research Office must be provided and emailed to Ms Phumzile Sibanyoni (SibanyoniP@ukzn.ac.za)
4. Incomplete applications will be rejected
5. The offer is valid till the **15 November 2022**.

PAINSA POSTGRADUATE STUDY RESEARCH GRANTS - CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The PainSA Research Grant provides financial support for members of PainSA registered at a South African University for a postgraduate research degree, and whose research is directly related to the field of pain.

PainSA hereby calls for applications for these two grants. The Foundational Grant is for members of PainSA undertaking full-time or part-time study towards an Honours or Masters degree in pain-related research and has a maximum value of R60 000. The Doctoral Grant is for members of PainSA undertaking full-time or part-time study towards a doctoral (PhD) degree in pain-related research, and has a maximum value of R80 000.

Deadlines: Applications close on **15 October 2022**, and recipients will be notified by 15 November 2022. Funds will be made available from January of the following year.

Application process: Applicants should review the information and complete an online application form at

Applicants are required to complete the application form with at least the following information:

- The applicant's motivation for undertaking the postgraduate study programme. This is expected to also address the specified review criteria.
- Two-page synopsis of planned research study
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copies of all academic transcripts
- Two reference letters from academics who have taught, supervised or worked alongside the applicant. At least one of the reference letters must be from the supervisor of the research for which the applicant is applying for support. The research supervisor's letter is expected to directly address the award review criteria.

INVITATION: INTRODUCTION TO BIOMEDICAL STATISTICS (SHORT COURSE PRESENTED BY CHS DOCTORAL ACADEMY)

Postgraduate students and emerging researchers are invited to register for our upcoming 4-part webinar series covering biomedical statistics.

Mon, 10 October

Tues, 11 October

Thurs, 13 October

Fri, 15 October

TIME - 3-5 pm

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a four-part webinar which provides an introduction to biomedical statistics. It is designed for the needs of people who have little knowledge of statistics, or who have some knowledge but lack confidence, or may have attended a statistics course previously but left feeling that they hadn't really understood what was being said!

The initial focus is on achieving an understanding of the underlying concept of sample variation and of statistical significance. This is followed by discussion of the principles and purpose of some of the most commonly used statistical tests, particularly t tests, ANOVA, Mann-Whitney U test, chi-square and Fisher's exact tests, Pearson's r and Spearman's correlations, and linear regression. This is followed by an exploration of the relationship of sample size, effect size and power of a study. The emphasis throughout is on principles, and practicality, and not mathematics.

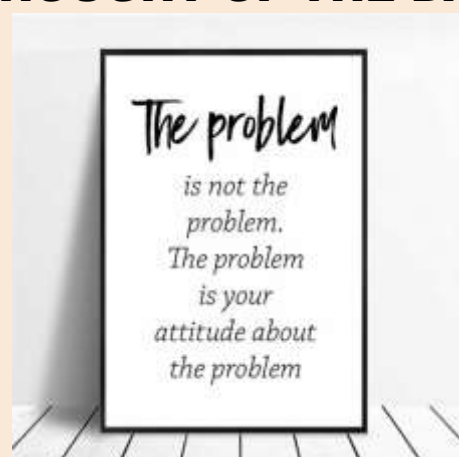
